## TROSLEY COUNTRY PARK THURSDAY 3 DECEMBER 2009

at

**Directions** From M20 J2 head north on the A227 towards Vigo Village. After about 2km turn

right into Harvel road (TQ 632611) and right again into Waterlow Road. Follow the road round and park by the junction with Croftside (**TQ 640614**). Nearest railway stations: Borough Green (approx 5km) and Meopham (approx 9km).

**Courses** 60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Double sided map. Visit as many

controls as you can on one side before turning over. Once turned over, no turning

back. Penalties for lateness!

**Map and Terrain** 1:7,500 map with 5m contours, updated Spring 2009 by Simon Holford. Maps will

be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Terrain consists of 170 acres of mixed woodland and steep chalk grassland slopes on the side of the North Downs. There

is a good path network throughout the park.

Coming? Please email or call the organiser if you intend coming so we know how many

maps to print. If you are new to Night Orienteering and would like someone to help you get started please email the organiser or make yourself known on the

night.

**Registration** 19:00 to 19:15 (please don't be late). Food orders will be taken at registration for

those who wish to eat at the pub afterwards. If possible please email the organiser

with your choice before the event (see separate menu).

**Start** We will be leaving the roadside parking at 19:20 for a mass start at 19:30 sharp.

**Equipment** SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one. Some sort of torch essential

plus a small backup/reserve. Whistle advisable.

**Cost** £2 per person. Dibber hire £1.

Après-O Royal Oak, London Road, Wrotham Heath (TQ 633580). Follow the A227 south

crossing over the M20 at the first roundabout. Follow the A20 towards Wrotham Heath. Cross over the M26 and the pub is about 500m on the right hand side.

**Prizes** A select few – of grandeur to reflect entry fee – at the pub afterwards.
