| Directions | The event will start and finish at the Tunbridge Wells Cricket Club in Nevill Gate, just off Warwick Park (TQ 587382). From the north, follow the A26 towards the Pantiles and take the A267 at the mini roundabout towards Frant. Turn left immediately after the pelican crossing into Warwick Park. Nevill Gate is about 900m up the hill on the left hand side. Nearest railway station is Tunbridge Wells $(1\frac{1}{2} \text{ km})$. |

| Courses | 60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can in the time. Penalties for lateness! |
| Map and Terrain | 1:15,000 scale map drawn Winter 2007/8 by Nick Barrable, updated 2009 by Simon Holford. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper (clue sheets will be on non waterproof paper). Streets and footpaths around Tunbridge Wells. |
| Coming? | Please email the organiser if you intend coming so we know how many maps to print. If you are new to Night Orienteering and would like someone to help you get started please email the organiser or make yourself known on the night. |
| Registration | 19:00 to 19:15 (please don't be late). Maps available at registration so you can plan your route. |
| Start | Briefing and mass start at 19:30 sharp. |
| Equipment | SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one. Don't forget to bring a pen/pencil to write down the answers. Some sort of torch essential plus a small backup/reserve. Light coloured and/or reflective clothing highly recommended. |
| Cost | £2 per person to cover printing costs (includes dibber hire). |
| Après-O | In the Tunbridge Wells Harriers club house afterwards. Homemade bread and soup available for $\pounds 2.50$. There is also a bar. |
| Prizes | A select few – of grandeur to reflect entry fee – in the club house afterwards. |
