Course Details:

There are two courses: a **7 leg A course** and a **5 leg B course**. Each course has a number of classifications that a team can compete in.

A course – 7 legs - Open and Handicap classes

The Handicap System

The handicap points are calculated based on age group. Each age class is accorded a points value as follows:

Class	10	12	14	16	18	20	21	35	40	45	50	55	60	65+
Men	1	2	4	6	8	9	10	9	8	7	6	5	4	3
Women	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	6	5	4	3	2	1	0

The team total is the sum of all runners in the team. Each relevant class is permitted a maximum points score from the above table as follows:

Class Handicap

A Handicap 49 points or under

B Handicap 26 points or under

B Women's Handicap 26 points or under
