Directions

Leave the A21 at the Tonbridge South exit (TQ 582449) and follow the A26 down the hill towards Tonbridge. At the first roundabout turn left (opposite the Shell garage) into Brook Street. After about 1km turn right and follow signs to Haysden Country Park. Continue past the main car park and under the dual carriageway bridge. The car park is just past the bridge on the right hand side (**TQ 564455**). You will be given a car parking permit at registration which you will need to display in your windscreen. Nearest railway station Tonbridge (2km).

Courses

60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Two sets of 10 controls with a changeover control in between. Visit as many controls from the first set before switching over. Controls score 1 point each with a penalty for lateness of 1 point per minute/part minute.

Map and Terrain

1:7,500 scale map. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Haysden is very flat and runnable with many streams, lakes and a railway line with fixed crossing points to test route choice. Suitable for novice night orienteers.

Start

Mass start at 19:30 sharp.
