1 Directions and Parking

Parking will be at the Haysden Country Park main car park. This is well signposted from Tonbridge town centre on the A26 towards Tunbridge Wells south from the railway station.

Registration will be in the far end of car park. Car parking is by pay and display, costing 60p for up to 4 hours. Toilets and a snack bar are available at the car park.

2 Courses

. Three courses will be available of approximate lengths;

Course A 6.0km technical for experienced orienteers

Course B 4.2km intermediate and less physical

Course C 2.3km simpler for beginners and juniors

These are longer than average due to the very flat and fast nature of the area.

3 Registration 1100 to 1230hrs

Starts 1100 to 1230hrs

4 Fees

 Seniors £4, Saxons Juniors free, Other Juniors £1. Family (2 adults & 2 children) £8.

Sportident cards (dibber) will be available for hire on the day for £1.00 each.

5 Map and terrain

. 1:7500 map. Mainly open land with complex river and railway crossings and path networks. This is a public park, but runs alongside deep water, so care is required.

Courses use well established bridges and tunnels to cross the river/railway, and no special precautions are required. Map surveyed in 2009.
