- Directions** From Forest Row follow the A22 south to the Wych Cross crossroads (TQ 419320). Turn right at the traffic lights and continue for about 2km until you reach another crossroads. Turn right then immediately left into the forest car park (**TQ 401326**). Please park neatly as space is limited. Nearest railway station East Grinstead (6km).
- Courses** 60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can. Controls score 1 point each with a penalty for lateness of 1 point per minute/part minute.
- Map and Terrain** 1:10,000 scale map with 5m contours. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Typical Ashdown Forest terrain consisting of mixed woodland and open heathland with a good path network.
- Coming?** **Please email the organiser if you intend coming** so we know how many maps to print. If you are new to Night Orienteering and would like someone to help you get started please email the organiser or make yourself known on the night.
- Registration** 19:00 to 19:15 (please don't be late).
- Start** Mass start at 19:30 sharp.
- Equipment** SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one. Some sort of torch essential plus a small backup/reserve. Whistle strongly advised.
- Cost** £2 per person. Dibber hire £1.
- Après-O** The Red Lion at Chelwood Gate, RH17 7DE. Retrace route to Wych Cross crossroads. Turn right at the traffic lights then right again after 150m into Lewis Road (A275). The pub is located about 1.5 km on the left hand side.
