



Knole Park, Sevenoaks

District Event

Saturday 13th February 2010



Location	Knole Park, Sevenoaks – a magnificent 1,000 acre deer park and a Site of Special Scientific Interest. Knole House is the birthplace of novelist and poet Vita Sackville-West.
Map and Terrain	Map scale 1:10 000 for all courses. Knole Park is a small undulating area of fast runnable open parkland with a small woodland area in the east and at this time of year it is at its best for orienteering, with the winter weather reducing the seasonal vegetation.
Car Park	Parking on hard standing in Sevenoaks School car park (Solefields Road), off main A225 where the High Street runs into Tonbridge Road (Grid Ref: TQ 531538). Signed from the junction of the A225 only. Parking fee: £1 - please have this ready when you enter the car park. <u>PLEASE DO NOT DEPOSIT ANY MUD FROM YOUR SHOES IN THE CAR PARK!</u>
Start	Start is approximately 500m from the car park along the A225. It will be necessary to cross this major road into the Park. There are islands in the middle of the road at the junction with Solefields Road - please use these for your own safety. Children <u>MUST</u> be accompanied and supervised when crossing this road both going to the start and returning from the finish.
Dogs	Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times in the Park. Please keep them away from the deer.
Conditions of Use	<p>Our use of Knole Park is subject to a number of conditions. It is essential that ALL these conditions are scrupulously followed if we are to continue to enjoy this area for orienteering :</p> <p>The golf course (tees, fairways and greens) is out of bounds. Transgressors will be disqualified. Courses may cross the golf course on metalled paths only.</p> <p>The perimeter fences may not be climbed. Crossing points (gates and stiles) are marked on the map and should be used where necessary. The various plantations marked on the map by uncrossable fences are all out of bounds.</p>

Fees	Seniors running Light Green and above £7. Seniors running Orange or Yellow £5 BOF members £2 discount on the above. SAX Juniors FREE. Other Juniors £3
Electronic Punching	Sportident will be used on all courses. SI dibbers will be available for hire at £1
Courses	Brown, Blue, Green, Orange, Yellow.
Facilities	Public toilets in Buckhurst Lane (adjacent to car park). These are the only toilets in the area and are some distance from the car park. Please visit en route! Squash at download in the car park. Nearest A&E Tunbridge Wells (minor accident unit at Sevenoaks Hospital)
