

Knole Park, Sevenoaks West Kent Series District Event Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2010



Location Knole Park, Sevenoaks – a magnificent 1,000 acre deer park and a Site of Special Scientific Interest. Knole House is the birthplace of novelist and poet Vita Sackville-West.

Knole Park is a small undulating area of fast runnable open parkland with a small woodland area in the east and at this time of year it is at its best for orienteering, with the winter weather reducing the seasonal vegetation.

- Car Park The car park is in the Sevenoaks School car park in **Solefields Road**, off the main A225 through the centre of Sevenoaks where the High Street runs into Tonbridge Road at grid reference 531538 and will be signed from the junction of the A225 only. Post Code TN13 1PG. There is a car park fee is £1 so please have this ready when you enter the car park. The car park is on hard standing <u>PLEASE</u> DO NOT DEPOSIT ANY MUD FROM YOUR SHOES IN THE CAR PARK!
- Start The start is approximately 500m from the car park along the main A225. It will be necessary to cross this major road into the Park. There are keep-left islands in the middle of the road at the junction with Solefields Road. Please use these islands for your own safety. Children <u>MUST</u> be accompanied and supervised when crossing this road both going to the start and returning from the finish.
- Dogs Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times in the Park. Please keep them well away from the deer.
- Conditions Our use of Knole Park is subject to a number of conditions, which must be observed. It is essential that ALL these conditions are scrupulously followed if we are to continue to enjoy this area for orienteering :

The golf course (tees, fairways and greens) is out of bounds and transgressors will be disqualified. Courses may cross the golf course on metalled paths only. Please take these restrictions very seriously and do not jeopardise our relationship with the golf club or the landowners.

The perimeter fences may not be climbed. Crossing points (gates and stiles) are marked on the map and should be used where necessary.
