



# Knole Park, Sevenoaks

## West Kent Series District Event

### Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> October 2010



Location	Knole Park, Sevenoaks – a magnificent 1,000 acre deer park and a Site of Special Scientific Interest. Knole House is the birthplace of novelist and poet Vita Sackville-West.
Map and Terrain	The map – longer courses will be 1:15000 and shorter courses will be 1:10000 Knole Park is a small undulating area of fast runnable open parkland with a small woodland area in the east.
Car Park	Follow the Leisure Centre & Library Car Park signs off the High Street at the traffic lights into Suffolk Way. Registration will be located in the far left hand corner (at the top of the slope) where a footpath leads down a steep hill into Knole Park.
Dogs	Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times in the Park. Please keep them well away from the deer.
Conditions of Use	<p>Our use of Knole Park is subject to a number of conditions, which must be observed. It is essential that ALL these conditions are scrupulously followed if we are to continue to enjoy this area for orienteering :</p> <p>The golf course (tees, fairways and greens) is out of bounds and transgressors will be disqualified. Courses may cross the golf course on metalled paths only. Please take these restrictions very seriously and do not jeopardise our relationship with the golf club or the landowners.</p> <p>In addition the National Trust have imposed a restriction that runners are not to cross the estate access road which leads to the house and in addition runners are not to cross in front of the house.</p> <p>The perimeter fences may not be climbed. Crossing points (gates and stiles) are marked on the map and should be used where necessary. The various plantations marked on the map by uncrossable fences are all out of bounds.</p>

Fees	Courses close 2:00pm Seniors running Light Green and above £7. Seniors running Orange or Yellow £5 BOF members £2 discount on the above. SAX Juniors FREE. Other Juniors £3
Electronic Punching Courses	Sportident will be used on all courses. SI dibbers will be available for hire at £1 Yellow, Light Green, Green, Blue and Brown. Sorry – no string course.
