| Location                    | Knole Park, Sevenoaks – a magnificent 1,000 acre deer park and a Site of Special Scientific Interest. Knole House is the birthplace of novelist and poet Vita Sackville-West.   |
| Map and Terrain             | The map – longer courses will be 1:15000 and shorter courses will be 1:10000<br>Knole Park is a small undulating area of fast runnable open parkland with a small woodland area in the east.  |

| Dogs                        | Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times in the Park. Please keep them well away from the deer.   |
| Conditions of Use           | <p>Our use of Knole Park is subject to a number of conditions, which must be observed. It is essential that ALL these conditions are scrupulously followed if we are to continue to enjoy this area for orienteering :</p> <p>The golf course (tees, fairways and greens) is out of bounds and transgressors will be disqualified. Courses may cross the golf course on metalled paths only. Please take these restrictions very seriously and do not jeopardise our relationship with the golf club or the landowners.</p> <p>The perimeter fences may not be climbed. Crossing points (gates and stiles) are marked on the map and should be used where necessary. The various plantations marked on the map by uncrossable fences are all out of bounds.</p> |
