

SE Relays Final Details

Access

The entrance to the forest will be signposted and is at grid reference TR 016 504, on the A251 approximately 700m SE from the A251 / A252 roundabout.

Parking is on forest tracks. Please observe a 15 mph speed limit within the forest. A walk of up to 1.5 km may be necessary to reach the assembly area.

A fee of £1 per car will be required.

Toilets will be available at the assembly end of the parking area.

Squash will be available at the finish.

First leg runners should be in the waiting pen ready for call-up 10 mins before their allotted start time.

Any course may have variants and/or gaffles, please ensure that younger runners understand this.

Mini-mass starts for any remaining runners (as needed) will start at 1:30

Bibs – Team bibs will not be issued, it is up to you to recognise your incoming runner.

Maps – Maps are printed on water-proof paper and will not be bagged. Scale 1:10 000. Control descriptions are printed on the maps.

Maps will not be collected. Please uphold the spirit of fair-play and do not discuss your course with competitors yet to run.

Terrain - Challock features many depressions which range from very shallow to very deep, both maps symbols are used (U and tagged oval).

This is an actively managed forest with many areas of coppice. Some areas shown as “felled” (open land with white screen) have already re-grown sufficiently to impede progress. However courses mostly avoid such areas.
