The 2011 South East Relays will take place at King's Wood, Challock close to Junction 9 of the M20 (Ashford), South ~West of Canterbury. King's Wood, Challock is delightful and generally runnable area of mixed woodland

Open/W Open: Blue/Green/Blue in that order

Handicap: Blue/Green/Orange in random order, team score No more that 46

Junior: Yellow/Orange/Yellow in that order, M/W18 or less and a team score no more than 35
