Directions	From Maidstone follow signs for the A229 (Hastings). Once you have left the town centre one way system, turn right at the first set of traffic lights into Armstrong Road (signed South Park Business Village). There is a small car park on the left next to Maidstone Hockey Club ( <b>TQ 764543</b> ) plus limited on road parking – share lifts were possible. Nearest railway stations Maidstone East & Maidstone West (approx 2.5km). Registration, Start and Finish are at the car park.
Courses	60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can.
Map and Terrain	1:10,000 scale map drawn March 2009 by Simon Holford. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper (clue sheets will be on non waterproof paper). Streets and footpaths around South Maidstone.

Registration	19:00 to 19:15 (please don't be late). Maps available at registration.
Start	Briefing and mass start at 19:30 sharp.
Equipment	SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one. <b>Don't forget to bring a pen/pencil to write down the answers</b> . Some sort of torch essential plus a small backup/reserve. Light coloured and/or reflective clothing highly recommended.
Cost	Seniors £3, Juniors £1 (Saxons Juniors FREE). Dibber hire £1.
