MILL BANK WOODS, NEAR SEVENOAKS SUNDAY 27th MARCH 2011

Terrain: The area comprises runnable mixed woodland with a good path and track

network and some interesting contour features. Nearest railway station:

Sevenoaks.

Directions: From the A225 at the southern outskirts of Sevenoaks (TQ 537526, just south

of White Hart Pub) follow Gracious Lane and signposts to Ide Hill. Cross straight over Weald Road after the stop sign. Turn left over the bridge over the A21, signposted to Ide Hill and Edenbridge. Take the first right at the crossroads and the entrance will be on the right (TQ 517524). The closest post code is TN14 6HR, just south of the final cross roads above. Parking on forest tracks. Parking is limited – please car share if possible. £1 parking fee which

will be donated to a charity nominated by the landowners

Courses: Yellow (2.5k), Orange (3k), Light Green (3.5k), Green (4.5k), Blue (6.5k) and

Brown (8k) – provisional lengths. See the Saxons website to find the most appropriate course for your experience. Start, Finish, Registration and parking are close together. None of the courses cross roads. The area is not very

friendly for childrens buggies.

Entry: Entry on the day

Dogs: Dogs are allowed on the courses but strictly on leads only.

Registration: 10:00 – 12:00

Starts: 10:30 – 12:30 (courses close at 14.30) – Note Clocks go forward night before

Fees: Seniors £7.00 (BOF discount £2), juniors £3, Saxon juniors free. SI dibber hire

£1.

Other details: Squash at finish. THERE ARE NO TOILETS at the site. The nearest public

toilets are at Sevenoaks Bus Station
