**Directions** 

From the junction of the A229 and A262 (TQ 782373) take the A262 east towards Sissinghurst & Biddenden. In Sissinghurst village turn right onto a minor road towards Benenden. Go straight across at the first crossroads and after about 2½ km turn left. Park in the Forestry Commission car park (TQ 812344) 500m on the left. Space is limited so please park as neatly as possible. Nearest railway stations Staplehurst and Headcorn (approx 12km).

Courses

60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can.

Map and Terrain

1:10,000 map with 5m contours, updated 2008 by Simon Beck. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Mixed forest with a good path network.
