

SAXONS ORIENTEERING CLUB invites you to a KENT NIGHT CUP EVENT WALDERSLADE STREET O THURSDAY 12 JANUARY 2012



Under 16's may take part in this event non-competitively provided they are accompanied by an adult at all times and the adult assumes full responsibility for them. Note that neither the junior nor the accompanying adult will be eligible for KNC league points.

Directions	From the M2 Junction 3 roundabout (TQ 749625) take the exit signposted Walderslade. Turn right at the traffic lights. Keep to the left and take the next left at the roundabout into Fostington Way. Take the first right into Tunbury Avenue. Parking/Registration, Start & Finish will be at Tunbury Primary School, ME5 9HY (TQ758624) 200 metres on the right. Nearest Railway station: Chatham (5km).
Courses	60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can.
Map and Terrain	1:10,000 scale map drawn March 2011 by Simon Holford. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Streets and footpaths around Walderslade (some hilly).
Coming?	<u>Please email the organiser if you intend coming</u> so we know how many maps to print. If you are new to Night Orienteering and would like someone to help you get started please email the organiser or make yourself known on the night.
Registration	19:00 to 19:15 (please don't be late).
Start	Briefing and mass start at 19:30 sharp.
Equipment	SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one. Note: This event will use full electronic punching – i.e. no clue sheet/pen to carry . Some sort of torch essential plus a small backup/reserve. Light coloured and/or reflective clothing highly recommended.
Cost	Seniors £3, Juniors £1 (Saxons Juniors FREE). Dibber hire £1.
Après-O	The Robin Hood Pub, Common Road, Blue Bell Hill (TQ737627) just off Junction 3 of the M2. There is a large car park at the pub. Menu available at registration.
Prizes	Prizes for first 10 (plus first female, if not in first 10) at the pub afterwards.
