Directions Leave A21 at Tonbridge South exit (TQ 582449) and follow A26 down the hill

towards Tonbridge. Turn left at first roundabout (opposite Shell garage) into Brook Street. After 1km turn right and follow signs to Haysden Country Park. Continue past main car park and under dual carriageway bridge. Car park is just past bridge on the right hand side (**TQ 564455**). Nearest railway station Tonbridge (2km).

Courses 60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can.

Map and Terrain 1:7,500 scale map with 5m contours. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper.

Flat and runnable with many streams & lakes, a railway line, and the River

Medway with fixed crossing points to test route choice.

Start Briefing and mass start at 19:30 sharp.

plus a small backup/reserve. Whistle advisable.

Cost Seniors £3, Juniors £1 (Saxons Juniors FREE). Dibber hire £1.

Free parking in Waitrose car park. From event car park, turn left and follow Lower Haysden Road to junction with Brook Street. Turn left and follow Brook Street back to the A26, turning left at mini roundabout. Continue straight on over next roundabout. Turn right at roundabout just past station into Vale Road. Continue past Sainsburys and take next left into Avenue du Puy. Turn left at mini

roundabout into Sovereign Way. Car park is on left hand side.
