Directions

From Maidstone, follow the A229 south towards Hastings. At the first traffic light controlled junction approximately 1km south of the town centre turn right onto Armstrong Road (signposted "South Park Business Village"). Parking and registration in the public car park on the left (to the south of Armstrong Road) (TQ 764543). Nearest railway stations are Maidstone East (Victoria to Ashford) (3.2km) and Maidstone West (London Bridge via Strood to Tonbridge/Paddock Wood) (2.9km).

Courses

60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can in the time available; a penalty for getting back late! The controls will be in the form of clues; these will all be lampposts, post boxes or fire hydrants (identified on the clue sheet), and will be multiple choice. No guessing, please!

Map and Terrain

1:10,000 scale map with 5m contours. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. This is a street-o with suburban and post war housing estates, as well as landscaped areas and a small area of woodland. Footpaths may be muddy. There are busy roads traversing the map; please exercise caution when crossing them and use crossing points where possible. Hi vis is strongly recommended.
