This is the final event in the 2011 - 2012 Kent Orienteering League series. The usual four courses will be available ranging from D (Yellow, ideal for beginners) to A (Blue, for more experienced orienteers)

#### Directions and Parking

Courses will start and finish adjacent to Pembury Recreation Ground off Lower Green Road, Pembury. Results and presentations will be held in the park at approximately 1330. Please park in Ridgeway (Postcode TN2 4EX, Grid reference TQ629411) and adjoining residential streets. Take care not to obstruct residential access. Please do not use the small car parking area within the park.

We will be using a small undulating area of mixed woodland with lots of tracks and footpaths and a couple of small streams. Shorter courses will keep to the paths. **The map scale will be 1:5000.**
