**HEMSTED FOREST near Cranbrook**  
**Saturday 16 March 2013**

*Courses suitable for beginners to experienced orienteers.*

**Terrain:** The event takes place in Hemsted Forest. It is managed by the Forestry Commission and is a mix of woodland and open land, and contains a good mix of contours and features.

**Directions:** From Sissinghurst on A262, go south towards Benenden. Turn left opposite Benenden school. Parking is in Forestry Commission car park at TQ811342 TN17 4AY

The infrequent 297 bus from Tunbridge Wells to Tenterden goes through Benenden village and passes the junction of Golford Rd and Goddards Green Road . The Hemsted Forest car park is just 500m from the junction.

Nearest railway station Staplehurst (10km). Nearest toilets centre of Cranbrook 5 k.
