HEMSTED FOREST near Cranbrook- Saturday 16 March 2013

Courses suitable for beginners to experienced orienteers.

Terrain: The event takes place in Hemsted Forest. It is managed by the Forestry Commission and is a mix of woodland and open land, and contains a good mix of contours and features.

Directions: Parking and registration is in the Forestry Commission car park in Goddards Green Road at TQ811342 TN17 4AY. From Sissinghurst on A262, go south towards Benenden on Chapel Lane and then Golford Road. Turn left opposite Benenden School. The 297 bus between Tunbridge Wells and Tenterden goes through Benenden village and passes the junction of Golford Rd and Goddards Green Road. The car park is just 500m from the junction. Nearest railway station Staplehurst (10km). Nearest toilets - centre of Cranbrook 5 k.
