



# Hucking Woodland

16 November 2013

Kent Orienteering League (KOL Event 3)



<b>Venue :</b>	Hucking Woodland is owned by the Woodland Trust and is mixture of mature woodland, open farm land and blocks of immature native woodland, all with a good path network. The map has had a major update over the last couple of months.
<b>Map :</b>	1:10,000 scale with 5m contours. Major map update autumn 2013 by N. Speers & P. Basford.
<b>Directions :</b>	Best from the A20 at Hollingbourne. Take the B2163 north through Hollingbourne Village and then up Hollingbourne Hill. Just after the top of the hill is a cross roads. Take the left turn, signed to Hucking, and follow the O signs to the parking. Public transport: The nearest train station is Hollingbourne (4km to 5km) on the Maidstone to Ashford railway line.
<b>Car Parking :</b>	Parking is on the access track south of St Margaret's Church, Hucking, ME17 1QT. Grid Ref TQ845582
<b>Registration :</b>	In the car park between 10:30hrs and 12:30hrs.
<b>Courses :</b>	Four courses are available to suit all abilities. <b>Course A (Blue) 6.0km</b> – As technical as the area allows. <b>Course B (Light Green) 4.0km</b> – Less technical and physical than Course A. <b>Course C (Orange) 2.5km</b> – Technically easy. To provide progression from Course D. <b>Course D (Yellow) 2.0km</b> – Technically easy. Suitable for beginners. Courses close at 14:00hrs. The competition area does not involve any road crossings. Equipment: SPORTIDENT timing will be used. If you don't have a dibber, they are available to hire from registration for £1. Lost hired dibbers will be charged at a cost of £30.
<b>Fees :</b>	Seniors £6 (BOF Senior Members £5) Juniors £3 Dibber Hire £1
<b>Starts :</b>	10:45hrs to 12:30hrs.
<b>Facilities :</b>	There are no toilet facilities at the event. Please use the M20 Maidstone Services on the way to the event if needed.
<b>Results :</b>	Results will be available on the DFOK website within a few days of the event.
<b>Further information :</b>	Are you coming to the event with a large group? If you are then please email the Organiser with an approximate number of competitors and likely courses so additional maps can be printed. Thanks.
