**Directions** 

Meet at **Discovery School hall**, Discovery Drive, Kings Hill, near West Malling Kent. Post code: ME19 4GJ. Approach Kings Hill estate from the roundabout on A228 about 2.5k south of its junction with the A20. Go straight across next three roundabouts, half-right at fourth and left at fifth onto Discovery drive. Continue ahead (one more roundabout) to Discovery school on the right.

Nearest railway station West Malling approx. 2.5k

Courses

60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can.

Map and Terrain

New 1:7,500 scale map. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Urban terrain with an interesting mix of road, alleyways and footpaths joining small areas of parkland. NOTE: Control Descriptions will be separate.

Anyone under 16 years of age on the day must be accompanied by a responsible
