

Jeskyns Community Woodland and Ashenbank

10 October 2013



Kent Night Cup (KNC Event 3)

Venue :	Jeskyns is a community woodland owned by the Forestry Commission. It is generally rough open with blocks of immature native woodland. Ashenbank is mature woodland owned by the Woodland Trust with a good path network.
	The map has had a major update over the last couple of weeks.
Мар:	1:0,000 scale with 5m contours. Major map update autumn 2013 by N. Speers.
Directions :	From the A2 take either: • The Gravesham East exit and follow signs south to Sole Street / Cobham (2 miles) • The Cobham / Shorne exit and follow the signs south to Cobham (1.5 miles) Public transport: The nearest train station is Sole Street (2.5km) on the London to Rochester railway line.
Car Parking :	Parking is at The Leather Bottle Hotel, The Street, Cobham, DA12 3BZ. This is towards the west end of the village. Please park at the far end of the car park. Grid Ref TQ669684
Registration :	In the car park between 19.00hrs and 19.15hrs.
Courses :	Suitable for all abilities. Mass start 19.30hrs. Twenty controls in total, as two sets of ten controls. Collect as many as you can manage in one set before switching to the second set. Within each set controls can be taken in any order. Maximum time allowance 60 minutes. Course closes 20.30hrs. Control value 1 point, with 1 point deducted for each minute or part minute you are late back. The competition area does not involve any road crossings.
	Equipment: SPORTIDENT timing will be used. If you don't have a dibber, they are available to hire from registration for £1. Lost hired dibbers will be charged at a cost of £30.
Fees:	Seniors £4 and Juniors £1.
Starts :	19.30hrs There is a short walk to the start and so we will be leaving registration at 19:25hrs. Please arrive in good time.
Facilities :	There are toilets in the bar area of the hotel. No muddy shoes please.
Results :	Results will be available at the après-O on the night (see below) and on the DFOK website within a few days.
