

## **Saxons Orienteering Club**

presents a Kent Orienteering League event at University of Kent, Canterbury Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> October 2013

1. Directions and Parking

From M2 at junction 7 join A2. Follow signs to Canterbury on A2050 but after ½ mile, at traffic lights turn left towards Rough Common. After a mile, at roundabout turn right onto A290 and then left after 300m into campus.

From other directions, follow ring road and take A290 towards Whitstable. After a mile, near the top of the hill, entrance is on the right.

Parking is on Giles Lane

Nearest train stations, Canterbury West and Canterbury East (the UNI bus runs close to both stations and will take you to the University campus – alight at Science Building or Gulbenkian Theatre stop and walk to the car park).

- 2. Grid Ref: TR140601 Closest post code CT2 7NZ
- 3. Courses

Electronic punching (SportIdent) will be used.

Four courses will be available

Course A 6.0 km (Blue) as technically challenging as the terrain will allow Course B 3.1 km (Lt. Green) less technical and less physical than course A Course C 3.0 km (Orange) to provide progression from course D Course D 2.1 Km (Yellow) technically easy, following linear features, ideal for beginners

4. Registration 10:30 to 12:30hrs Starts 10:45 to 12:30hrs

Courses close at 14:00

- 5. Fees Seniors: £6 (BOF members £5) Juniors £3 (Saxons junior £1) Dibber hire £1
- Map and terrain
  1:5 000 map. The campus is a mix of open grassland, woods and urban setting.
