## SAXONS ORIENTEERING CLUB invites you to the KENT NIGHT CUP Round 10 at ABBEY WOOD Langley nr Maidstone THURSDAY 28th NOVEMBER 2013

**Directions** Nearest Post code: ME17 1SX. O.S.148 TQ 815 518

The wood is on the road between Leeds and Langley Heath [B2163],

**From the south** via A274 to Five Wents then north along the Leeds Road for 1/2 mile turn left into Horseshoes Lane

However if you prefer to approach **from the north** there are road works to be avoided. From the A20 turn towards Leeds Castle [B2163] and at top of Penfold Hill take Burberry Lane which is straight ahead where the more major road turns right. After a mile the Lane will turn right and  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile further you return to the B2163. Turn left and Horseshoes Lane is a short distance on the right

Parking in Horseshoes Lane or Copperfield Drive

**Courses** 60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can. 10 x 90s and 10x 100s with a change over control no 111

Map and Terrain 1:10,000 scale map with 5m contours, updated October 2013.

Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper.

This is a small area with pleasant woodland and decent path network. The wood is crossed by two East to West roads which divide the wood into three distinct sections

Coming? Please email the Organiser if you intend coming so we know how many maps to print.

If you are new to Night Orienteering and would like someone to help you get started please email the organiser or make yourself known on the night.

**Registration** 19:00 to 19:15 (please don't be late). Short walk to mass **start sharp at 19.30**.

**Equipment** SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one. Some sort of torch is essential plus a small backup/reserve. Carrying a whistle is mandatory (as a casualty, blow six short blasts, wait 1 min, repeat).

Cost Seniors £4, Juniors £1. Dibber hire £1.

**Après-O** Come along to the "Crown and Horseshoes" after your run. It's on your way home (W. end of Horseshoes La. ME17 3LZ) and you can have a chat about your route choice, successes and failures to people who will understand, congratulate or sympathise with you.

**Prizes** Prize giving will take place in the pub afterwards, so another good reason to come along
