CANTERBURY (Street-O)

Directions

From the A2, follow the A2050 towards Canterbury city centre. At the 2nd roundabout turn right onto the Canterbury ring road (A290/A28). At the 2nd roundabout, turn left into Watling Street. Park in Watling Street car park (100metres on the left - free after 6pm). Nearest Postcode **CT1 2TN**. There are 170+ spaces but Thursday night is late night shopping in Canterbury, so if this is full there are a multitude of other options. See <http://www.canterbury.gov.uk/main.cfm?objectid=5815> for details. Note, fees apply up to 9pm at most of the other car parks.

Canterbury has two stations:

Canterbury East (trains from Victoria via Maidstone or Rochester) is 500 metres from Watling St. Take the footbridge over the ring road and cross Dane John Park.

Canterbury West (trains from other London stations including the High Speed line) is 1.1km away.

Registration, start, and finish will be at the junction of Watling Street, and Rose Lane (north side)

Courses

60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can subject to the rules below. Full electronic recording using SportIdent units attached to lamp posts (mostly). 30 controls in total. These are split into two sets: odds and evens. Visit as many as you want from one set, then switch to the other. Points values per control vary from 10 to 50. A 20 point penalty for each minute or part minute taken over 60 minutes will be applied.

Map and Terrain

1:6,000 scale map with 5m contours. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. The area used will be the same as for the 2012 Canterbury Urban race with the map reduced in scale to fit onto a sheet of A4.
