Blean Woods, nr Faversham Sunday 13th April 2014

- Parking is in the grounds of Mount Ephraim House (only 10 minutes from the M2). When travelling from the west along the M2 this is best approached by continuing past the end of the M2 (J7) onto the A299 and taking the first left, marked by a brown sign to Farming World. Turn left again to cross over the A299 and then turn right at the T junction to continue into Staplestreet. Before reaching the Three Horseshoes pub turn left (signposted Hernhill Church / Whitstable). After 500m turn right into the grounds of Mount Ephraim. Parking will be 250m on the right.

3. Courses

Electronic punching (SportIdent) will be used.

Six courses will be available following BOF guidelines : Brown 7.9 km technically difficult for the fit and experienced Blue 6.1 km technically difficult but shorter Green 4.7 km technical but les physical Light Green 3.6 km less technical for intermediates Orange 2.5 km for progression, basic use of compass and some route choice Yellow 1.7 km basic for beginners and children
