Directions

Parking and registration will be in the main FC car park at GR TR 024 500. Nearest

postcode is TN25 4AP (800m SE of car park).

From M20 Jct. 9, go North A251, 8Km to Challock, after speed limit signs turn

right onto White Hill; after 400m turn left into forest car park

If approaching from the M2 (Jct6), at the roundabout at Challock, where the A251 & A252 cross, take the SE exit signposted Ashford. After 1 km bear left onto White Hill minor road with a brown sign indicating 'Stour Valley Arts'. The car park is

found on the left after 400m.

There is a height restriction at the entrance to the car park.

Nearest railway station Wye (4.1km).

Courses

60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can.

Map and Terrain

1:10,000 scale map with 5m contours, updated 2014. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Terrain: Working Forestry Commission woodland with forest

roads and good path network.
