<i>Directions</i>	Grid reference TQ 418344, postcode RH18 5JA Michael Hall School off Priory Road, Forest Row, East Sussex: Park in top corner of car park Car parking fee £2.
<i>Courses</i>	Brown :- 8.0k, Blue :- 6.4k, Green:- 4.8k, L Green :- 3.4k, Orange:- 2.6k, Yellow:- 2.1k Courses Brown, Blue and Green will have a timed road crossing. Other courses do not cross any roads.
<i>Map</i>	1:10,000 Map revised and updated 2013 by Roger Maher. Minor updates by David Kingdon
<i>Terrain</i>	Hindleap Warren has a great mix of open land, runnable forest, rides and features There is an area of Special Scientific Interest marked with purple lines. Rare flowers grow in this area. Please observe the out of bounds marking.
<i>Registration</i>	9:45 am to 11.45 in the Michael Hall School car park.
<i>Starts</i>	10am to 12.00 (courses close at 2:00pm). Start times will not be pre-allocated. Start when you are ready. The start is a flat 800m from registration. This will pass the finish after 600m, where clothing can be dropped.
