- Directions** Post code: TN24 8QQ, Bybrook Barn Harvester, Canterbury Road, Kennington.
From M20 J9, head SW and turn east at the first roundabout. At the traffic lights at the end of this road, turn left. Cross back over the M20 and the pub and parking is on the left.
- Nearest railway station** Ashford International (2km).
- Courses** 60 minute street score event suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can. Points values range from 10 to 50 per control. Penalty of 20 points per minute or part minute late.
- Map and Terrain** 1:10,000 scale map with 5m contours, January 2010 with minor revisions September 2014.
Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper.
- Coming?** Please email the organiser if you intend coming so we know how many maps to print. If you are new to Night Orienteering and would like someone to help you get started please email the organiser or make yourself known on the night.
- NOTE:** Juniors (age 15 or younger) are welcome to take part but must be accompanied by an adult. Their results (the junior and the accompanying adult) will not be counted for KNC rankings because they are not able to take part competitively for insurance reasons but we will of course record their time for their own purposes.
Note that juniors age 16 or over on the day do not need to be accompanied.
- Registration Start** 19:00 to 19:15 (please don't be late).
Briefing and mass start at 19:30 sharp.
- Equipment** SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one. Some sort of torch essential plus a small backup/reserve.
- Cost** Seniors £4, Juniors £1. Dibber hire £1.
- Après-O** Bybrook Barn Harvester (tbc – please look for confirmation on the website later in the week).
- Prizes** Prize giving will take place in the pub afterwards.
