Sevenoaks. Park in the top corner of car park by the Saxons banner. Car parking fee £1 by ticket

from machine.

2 Navy 5.2k 3 Olive 3.9k 4 Novice Beginner 2.6k

Championship: Medals will be given to the top 3 in each of the following categories:

Course 1 - M20-40, M45/50:

Course 2 - M18, M55/60, W20-40, W45/50: Course 3 - M16, M65+, W16, W18, W55/60, W65+

Course 4 M10-M14, W10-W14

Map scale: 1:10000. First use of new map revised and updated in summer 2014

Terrain: Knole is a beautiful deer park with a really nice mix of open/semi open areas and runnable forest

and is a superb venue for a night championships. Recent removal of the old deer fences around enclosures has improved the general runnability of the area. Be aware there may be loose ankle

height wire present where some of the enclosure fences have been removed.

Facilities: Toilets: 100m. Public Transport: Sevenoaks Station, 1km

Registration: 6pm -7.30pm

Starts: 6.30 to 7.45pm (courses close at 9:30pm). Whistles compulsory; there will be a whistle check at

the start. Start times will not be pre-allocated. Start when you are ready. Juniors can be shadowed on the novice course, but will not be eligible for a medal. Adults shadowing must do

their run first if they want to be eligible.
