	Sevenoaks Leisure Centre. No car parking charge on a Sunday.

Courses	Yellow (2.3k), Orange(3.4k), Light Green(3.8k), Green(5.2k),
	Blue (6.1k), Brown(7.9k)

Terrain	Knole Park is a beautiful 1000 acre medieval deer park with a mix
	of open/semi open and runnable forest. Recent removal of the old
	deer fences around enclosures has improved the runnability of the
	area.
Registration	10:00 – 11:45am in tent in the car park.
Start and	10:30 – 12:00 (courses close at 2:00pm)
Finish	All courses start 550m from the car park. (10 min walk). The
	route to the start crosses the vehicle entry road into the park. The
	traffic should be slow moving but please take care crossing the
	road.
	The Orange, Yellow and Light Green courses finish close to the
	start which means the route back to the car park crosses the
	same minor road. The remaining courses finish 250m from the
	car park . No competitor should have to cross a road with vehicles
	during their course.

	Knole House is magnificent; one of England's largest houses,
	renowned for having 365 rooms, 52 staircases, 12 entrances and
	7 courtyards. Its grade I listing reflects its mix of Elizabethan to
	late Stuart structures, particularly in the case of the central
	façade and state rooms. Access to showrooms is $\pounds 10.40$ for an
