Terrain: Knole is a beautiful deer park with a really nice mix of open/semi open and runnable forest. Recent removal of the old deer fences around enclosures has only served to improve the general runnability of the area.

Easy access from the M25. Knole Park contains one of England's largest houses - managed by the National Trust - 365 rooms, 52 staircases, 12 entrances and 7 courtyards. Well worth a visit after the event.
