1. Location

2. Directions and Parking
Mote Park is situated on the eastern side of Maidstone, south of but not directly accessible from, the A20. Brown direction signs will take you to the main entrance (do not follow the Leisure Centre sign) where registration will be sited in the main car park. The public car park is a reasonable size and there is no charge. This is however a popular local venue and parking may become tight for late arrivals - particularly if the weather is fine. Alternative car parking is available at the nearby Leisure Centre and at two small car parks accessed from Wellington Street to the east (next to the Park & Ride) and from School Lane to the south east
3. Courses
Electronic punching (SportIdent) will be used.
Four courses will be available
 Course A 6.7 km (Blue) as technically challenging as the terrain will allow
 Course B 4.0 km (Lt. Green) less technical and less physical than course A
 Course C 3.1 km (Orange) to provide progression from course D
 Course D 2.2 Km (Yellow) technically easy, following linear features, ideal for beginners
4. Registration 10:30 to 12:00hrs
Starts 10:30 to 12:30hrs

 Seniors: £6 (BOF members £5)
 Juniors £3 (Saxons junior £1)
 Dibber hire £1
6. Map and terrain
1 : 10 000 map. Much of the terrain is open runnable, around a central feature lake
