Directions	Shoreham Woods, Shacklands Rd., Badgers Mount, Sevenoaks TN14 7BD , Grid ref TQ 502616. From the M25 Jct. 4 link road take first left A244 Dunton Green Badgers Mount, then first left at next roundabout (2km) signed Shoreham village. Car Park is second on the right (400m) – noticeboard and gate. Knockholt station is 2.5km away.
Courses	60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can.
Map and Terrain	1:10,000 scale map with 5m contours, updated Spring 2012. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Woodlands with field in between, good path network. Hilly in places and can be slippery underfoot.
Coming?	<u>Please email the organiser if you intend coming</u> so we know how many maps to print. If you are new to Night Orienteering and would like someone to help you get started please email the organiser or make yourself known on the night.
Registration	19:00 to 19:15 (please don't be late).
Start	Briefing and mass start at 19:30 sharp.
Equipment	SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one. Some sort of torch essential plus a small backup/reserve. Carrying a whistle is mandatory (as a casualty, blow six short blasts, wait 1 min, repeat).
Cost	Seniors £4, Juniors £1. Dibber hire £1.
Après-O	Toby Pub and Carvery (Sevenoaks Badgers Mount) TN14 7AD very close by. From car park go back to roundabout, turn left A224 Sevenoaks and pub is on the right in 150m. If planning to eat please indicate and food choice if possible when reserving map, as the food requires ordering beforehand.
