- Directions** Fir Tree Rd **TN4 8AH** Car park adjacent to the cricket pitch Grid ref. TQ577392  
Nearest railway station: Tunbridge Wells 1.5km
- Course** 60 minute course suitable for all abilities. 2 parts in this sequence –  
Part A: Standard Score, then whenever you wish, turn map over for  
Part B: Line Course: controls must be done in ascending order but you can join the course where you like and also miss controls out (but see below).  
There is a mandatory road crossing with a control at each side All competitors must punch these two controls in sequence. It is on the line course.  
1 point per control, 1 point penalty per minute/part minute beyond 60 minutes.  
Juniors (age 15 or younger) are welcome to take part in this event but must be accompanied by an adult. Their results (the junior and the accompanying adult) will not be counted for KNC rankings because they are not able to take part competitively for insurance reasons but we will of course record their time for their own purposes. Note that juniors age 16 or over on the day do not need to be accompanied.
- Map and Terrain** 1:5,000 scale map with 5m contours. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. The Common has wooded and open areas and is crossed by a number of minor roads. NOTE Comment about Hi viz clothing and the mandatory road crossing
- Coming?** Please email the organiser if you intend coming (and see note about food, below) so we know how many maps to print. If you are new to Night Orienteering and would like someone to help you get started please email the organiser or make yourself known on the night.
- Registration** 19:00 to 19:15 (please don't be late)
- Start** Briefing and mass start at 19:30 sharp.
- Equipment** **Hi Viz** clothing or waistcoat  
SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one, some sort of torch and  
**Please note that British Orienteering have confirmed that every competitor must carry a whistle and a backup light and that the organising club must physically check at the start that a reasonable percentage of participants are complying with this rule. Please bear with us while this kit check is performed.**  
If you need to summon help, blow six short whistle blasts, wait 1 min, repeat.
