Kent Night Cup



Venue :	Shorne Woods is a public Country Park owned by Kent County Council. It is a mixture of mature woodland, coppice and new growth woodland, with some open areas. The area has an extensive path network. It is partially an old clay pit and has an abundance of earthwork and water features. Water features are generally wetter than indicated on the map. The map had a major update a year ago and minor updates this winter.
Map :	1:7,500 scale with 5m contours. Minor map updates Feb 2015 by N. Speers.
Directions :	From the A2 take: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Cobham / Shorne exit and then follow the brown Country Park signs towards Shorne. / Cobham. The Country Park entrance is on the left and the parking on the right on Park Pale Road. Public transport: The nearest train station is Sole Street (4.5km) on the London to Rochester railway line, or Higham (4.5km) on the North Kent Line.
Car Parking :	Parking will be along Park Pale, which is the road opposite the entrance to the Country Park. The post code for Shorne Country Park is DA12 3HX. Grid Ref TQ685698.
Registration :	At the parking area between 19.00hrs and 19.15hrs. If you have a dibber please bring it to registration as a dibbed registration system will be used.
Courses :	Suitable for all abilities. Mass start 19.30hrs. Twenty controls in total, as two sets of ten controls. Collect as many as you can manage in one set before switching to the second set at a change over control. Within each set controls can be taken in any order. Maximum time allowance 60 minutes. Course closes 20.30hrs. Control value 1 point, with 1 point deducted for each minute or part minute you are late back. The competition area does not involve any road crossings. Equipment: SPORTIDENT timing will be used. If you don't have a dibber, they are available to hire from registration for £1. Lost hired dibbers will be charged at a cost of £30.
Fees :	Seniors £4 and Juniors £1.
Starts :	19.30hrs There is a short walk to the start and so we will be leaving registration at 19:25hrs. Please arrive in good time.
Facilities :	None.
Results :	Results will be available at the après-O on the night (see below) and on the DFOK website within a few days.
