

Whitehorse Wood (Vigo) Night Event



19 March 2015

Kent Night Cup (KNC) - Event 25

Venue :	Whitehorse Wood (Vigo) is mainly a typical south-east coppice woodland, with some grass land areas on the scarp slope of the North Downs. The area includes an extensive path network, many earthwork features, including a WW2 trench system and the scarp slope of the North Downs.
Мар:	1:10,000 scale with 5m contours. 2013 map with updates spring 2015.
Directions :	From the M20 Jnt 4, take the A228 south for 0.5 mile. At the roundabout turn right onto Bull Lane (signed to Birling). Continue on this road for 1 mile to Birling Village and then turn right onto Snodland Road. After 0.5 mile turn left onto Stangate Road. Continue straight-on on this road for two miles (including climbing Birling Hill and pass the turning for Holly Hill. The parking at Badgells Wood Campsite is on the left.
	From A227 / A20 roundabout on Wrotham Hill, take the A227 north-east for two miles. Turn right at the sign for Vigo / Harvel. Follow Harvel Road / White Horse Road for three miles (signed Birling / Snodland / Holly Hill Open Space. The parking at Badgells Wood Campsite is on the right.
	Public transport: Not easy. The closest train station is Snodland and it is then 5km to the assembly / parking location. If you would like to be picked up from a local station then please contact the Organiser by Tuesday 17 March 2015.
Car Parking :	Parking on Badgells Wood Campsite, White Horse Road, Vigo (near DA13 0UF). TQ 664622
Registration :	At the parking location between 19.00hrs and 19.15hrs.
Courses:	Suitable for all abilities. Mass start 19.30hrs. Twenty controls in total, as two sets of ten controls (60s and 70s), with control values of 1 (odds), or 2 (evens) points. Collect as many as you can manage in one set before switching to the second set. Within each set controls can be taken in any order. Maximum time allowance 60 minutes. Course closes 20.30hrs. 2 points deducted for each minute or part minute you are late back. The competition area does not involve any road crossings.
Equipment :	In addition to a torch, and to comply with BOF rules and insurance requirements, all
Equipment .	competitors entering this event are required to carry an emergency torch and a whistle. Spot checks will be made for compliance with this. Equipment: SPORTIDENT timing will be used. <i>Please bring your dibber to registration as a punched registration system will be used for this event.</i> If you don't have a dibber, they are available to hire from registration for £1. Lost hired dibbers will be charged at a cost of £30.
Fees :	Seniors £4 and Juniors £1.
Starts : Facilities :	19.30hrs. Please arrive in good time.
Results :	Toilet facilities may be available in the parking area.
Results.	Results will be available at the après-O on the night (see below) and on the DFOK website within a few days.
