Directions

Nearest Post code: TN11 0PT. Parking, hopefully, will be in the small car park belonging to The RSPB Tudeley Woods Nature Reserve on Half Moon Lane (also known as Dislingbury Lane) Tudeley Kent TN11 0PT. We are not sure yet whether this will be unlocked for us. If not, parking will be along Half Moon Lane. Please park where it is sensible to do so allowing the passage of other cars on this very quite lane. From M25 J5 follow the A21 south for about 12 miles then turn left onto Half Moon Lane. This is very close to and just before the Shell petrol station if you are travelling south. You will come to the RSPB car park about half a kilometre along Half Moon Lane on the left.

If you miss Half Moon Lane you can turn left at Pembury Walks which is just after the Shell Garage. Drive to the end of this road, turn left into Old Church Road, then first left into Pembury Hall Road and continue along this road as it bends right until you come to the end of the road where you turn left and are then on Half Moon Lane.

Courses

60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can. First doing either odd or even numbers and then changing to do even or odd numbers.

Map and Terrain

1:7,500 scale map with 5m contours, updated March 2014. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Mixed forest with some intricate contour detail. Some steep slopes and a river valley. Although a small area it contains a lot of good 'white' forest
