Directions	Nearest Post code: <b>TN2 5ES, Tunbridge Wells Harriers,</b> Nevill Cricket Ground, Nevill Gate off Warwick Park. Nearest railway station Tunbridge Wells (1km). This is the club night of Tunbridge Wells Harriers who are joining in the run. We are using their club house which has showers, toilets and a very reasonably priced bar.
Courses	60 minute score suitable for all abilities. Visit as many controls as you can. 20 controls, 10 points each. Visit the 90s or the 100 series first then switch. You can only switch once. Optimum distance for all 20 approx 13.5km plus climb
	Juniors (age 15 or younger) are welcome to take part in Street events but should be accompanied by an adult. Their results (the junior and the accompanying adult) will not be counted for KNC rankings because they are not able to take part competitively for insurance reasons but we will of course record their time for their own purposes. Note that juniors age 16 or over on the day do not need to be accompanied.
Map and Terrain	1:10,000 scale map with 5m contours. Maps will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. 4 of the 20 controls will be in Tunbridge Wells Parks, so be prepared to run along some unlit paths. Please take care crossing roads and give way to traffic. Be considerate to pedestrians.

If you are new to Night Orienteering and would like someone to help you get started please email the organiser or make yourself known on the night.
Registration	Upstairs in the Club House 18:30 to 19:15 (please don't be late).
Start	Briefing and mass start at 19:30 sharp. The Harriers will have a punching start from 19:45, latecomers can start with them.
Equipment	SPORT IDENT dibbers to hire if you don't have one. Some sort of torch essential plus a small backup/reserve High Visibility clothing essential.
Cost	Per map/dibber - Seniors £4, Juniors £1. Dibber hire £1.
Après-O	We have organised a giant take-away from the Downtown fish bar at £5 per head to eat in the Club House. Your choice is fish (with or without batter), chicken, 2 veg spring rolls or a cheese onion pasty all with or without chips. So that Reg in the fish bar can buy enough fish we have to put in most of the orders by midday Monday 19 <sup>th</sup> . You will be able to order on the night but your choice may be restricted.
